I found online a Record of Indenture for Dewitt, with a date listed in 1827. It is my belief that Susannah died in late 1827, as Isaac remarried in early 1828, although it is interesting that on the listing for the 1828 marriage, it does not say that Isaac was a widower, as it did when he married Susannah he was married prior to Susannah. My question is this in both cases, when Henry Rodgers/Rogers died in 1821, what would have happened to their children? Would there be court records regarding the children? I believe the ages of those children, in 1821, ranged from @ 14 or 12 down to about 2. Same thing for the children with Isaac-if she passed in 1827 or so, would there be court records pertaining to the children Henry & Dewitt?
