- .0001 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Springfield Ignition storefront.
- .0002 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Ihrig Opticians storefront.
- .0003 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – storefront - H. G. Root Automotive Supplies.
- .0004 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – White Line Taxicab Service; three cars with 1923 license plates parked in front of a two-story brick house. Two men in uniform stand on either side of the middle car, each holding one end of a banner reading "White Line Taxi Service." Photo is glued to an album page, with letterhead for White Line Taxicab Service glued to page at bottom of photo.
- .0005 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – storefront, P. T. Rathbun & Co., Furnaces & Automobiles. Photo shows a display window with a large sign reading "Paige and Jewett Sales and Service"; banners and decals for Paige and Jewett automobiles. Photo is glued to an album page, with letterhead for P.T. Rathbun & Co. glued to page at bottom of photo.
- .0006 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – the C. S. Ball Candy Co.. Photo shows a storefront with two display windows flanking entryway; one window displaying various candies, the other soda fountain machinery. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued at bottom of photo.
- .0007 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Digan Cleaning & Dyeing. Photo shows two brick buildings with two trucks parked between them. The building on the left is one story, with "Digan Cleaning & Dyeing" painted directly on a brick wall extending vertically beyond the roof; street address numbers 117 & 119 painted on either side of the building; between address numbers is painted "Main Office 106 E. High St."; the building on the right is two stories, no signs or markings. The trucks parked between the buildings have the Digan and Master Dyers and Cleaners Association logos painted on their sides. Photo is glued to an album page; most of the page beyond the edges of the photo has fractured off; part of the page remaining on the left side of the photo has a color print of the circular Master Dyers and Cleaners Assc. logo pasted to it.
- .0008 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – M. D. Smith & Co. storefront.

- .0009 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Interior of the Crystal Restaurant (Gus Mantis, Manager) at 36 South Limestone Street. Restaurant is in a long, narrow room with a high ceiling covered with embossed tin plates. Lunch counter runs most of the length of the room on the left side of the photo, tables on the right side. Several employees and customers are shown. Photo is glued to a black album page with gold paint embellishments around the edges of the photo, and Crystal Restaurant letterhead glued beneath it.
- .0010 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Interior of Joseph H. Gnau Wall Paper and Decorations shop. Shows a small room with framed prints hanging on the walls, display racks of stationery and statuettes, and rolls of wallpaper displayed in the middle of the room. A shelf at the back holds small boxes and cans of what may be wallpaper paste. Photo is glued to a black album page with gold paint decoration around the edges of the photo, and the shop's letterhead glued beneath it.
- .0011 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Interior of Morrow's Drug Store. Room is two stories open to the ceiling, with a gallery running around the upper part of the room; photo was taken looking down from the gallery. The lower part of the room is divided lengthwise by a set of high shelves; on the left side is a shop area with counters and glass cases. On the right side of the shelves is a soda fountain/restaurant area. In the center of the room is a square column with a large clock on it. A sign on the gallery railing reads "We have thrown our keys away Open all night every night." Photo is glued to a black album page with gold paint decorations around the photo. Small pieces of typed paper listing the shop's goods and giving its name and slogan are glued beside and below the photo.
- .0012 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Exterior of the shop of Rosensteel & Weber, Home Furnishers at 51 – 53 West Main Street. There is a sign reading "Rosensteel and Weber" over the first-floor entryways. Other shops in the building are Charles Minogue, Auto Supplies; Ridgely Paint Shop; J. H. Reinheimer, Tailor; Bauroth Brothers Gas Engines (rear of building). A square-and-compass insignia on a cupola over the fourth floor indicates a Masonic temple in the building. Photo is glued to a black album page with Rosensteel & Weber letterhead glued below the photo
- .0013 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Interior of the Citizens' Garage at 1115 North Limestone Street. Shows an open, low-ceilinged room with a concrete floor, and automobiles parked between rows of round concrete support columns. Large windows admit natural light, and a sign painted on a far wall reads "absolutely no smoking." Photo is glued to a black album page, with gold paint decoration around the edges of the photo, and Citizens'

Garage letterhead glued below the photo (letterhead lists "automobile repairing," "storage," and "washing" as services offered by the garage).

- .0014 Album page – two photos and a piece of business stationery. One photo shows a counter within Morrow's Drug Store where Walter Phillips sold ties, collars, shirts, belts, and other menswear and accessories; the other photo shows a man, presumably Phillips, from the chest up. The stationery has "Walter Phillips Furnishings and Hats At Morrow's Drug Store," below which someone typed a list of the goods sold by Phillips. Photos and stationery have decorative borders drawn in gold paint on the album page.
- .0015 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Exterior, M. S. Arthur Electric Co. at 48 West High Street. Shows a ground-floor storefront with a display window in which various electric light fixtures and home appliances are displayed. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0016 Photo, B&W, 8 " x 10" – Exterior of Hodge Storage & Cartage at 113 West Jefferson. Shows a large, three-story brick building with a wooden cupola (?) and a large wing projecting to one side. On the main building is painted "STORAGE" and "Hodge Storage and Cartage Co." Train tracks are visible on the ground in the foreground of the photo. Photo is glued to an album page; a piece of paper with typed information about the company is glued below the photo.
- .0017 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Exterior of the Springfield Electric and Fixture Company. Shows a storefront with two windows displaying lightbulbs and electric irons. A punched tin (?) electric sign reading "Springfield Electric and Fixture Co." projects over the sidewalk, and there is a large sign for Baer Paints hanging over the front of the store. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0018 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" –C. F. Jackson Funeral Home. Shows a two-story house with a large portico. Photo is glued to an album page; a slip of paper with information about the business is glued below the photo.
- .0019 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – McKenzie Lumber and Coal Co. lumberyard and offices at Grand Avenue and Plum Street. Shows a large lot with multiple single-story buildings and piles of lumber in various states of processing, from unplanned logs with bark still on to finished planks. Photo taken from a high angle, somewhat above the roofs of the buildings. Photo is glued to an album page, with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.

- .0020 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – an area on the grounds of the McKenzie Lumber and Coal Co. Shows a corridor between two open lumber sheds where finished planks are stored. A man in a suit is leaning against one of the sheds on the left side of the photo, and a truck is parked at the far end of the corridor. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0021 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Main Street entrance of the Home Store. Shows a storefront with two entrances flanked by two display windows, with a display case between the doors. Clothing and bolts of cloth are displayed in the windows. A large sign over the entryway reads "The Home Store" and "The Fahien-Tehan Company." Photo is glued to an album page with the company letterhead glued below the photo; "H. J. Fahein, President" and "Edw. A. Tehan, Sec'y & Treas." are typed on the letterhead.
- .0022 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – National Systems Bakeries store operated by the Leffel Baking Company. Shows a storefront with a single entrance flanked by display windows displaying baked goods. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's stationery glued below the photo.
- .0023 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – V. L. Circle, Distributor of Durant and Star Motor Cars. Shows a single-story brick storefront with two large display windows on the left side and an open garage/carport on the right. The garage section has wooden double-doors that open horizontally, with a sign over them reading "Auto Inn;" a car is parked inside. The grill of a car is also visible in one of the display windows. There is a gasoline pump on the curb in front of the building. Photo is glued to an album page, with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0024 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – A wrecked car half-wrapped around a utility pole; license plates dated 1922. Car has... *had* a cloth roof, round headlights, running boards, wood-spoke wheels, and was a crank-start. One tire or wheel without spokes is lying in the street. Several men and a pair of girls are gathered around the accident. Photo is glued to an album page; glued underneath it is letterhead for the Ray Johnson Insurance Company at 326-328 Fairbanks Building, for which the picture was evidently an advertisement.
- .0025 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Exterior of the James-Bauer Realty Company at 109 E. Main St. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.

- .0026 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – the Howard B. DeWitt "Exide" Battery Station at Main & Lowry Avenue. Photo is glued to an album page, with the store's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0027 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Truck No. 10 of the W. P. Byerman Furniture and Piano Movers and Storage Company. Photo is glued to an album page, with a piece of the company's stationery glued below the photo.
- .0028 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – The Vulcan Hardware Company at 119-121 East Main Street. Other companies shown in the picture are Wobbe the Tailor, the Wi\_\_\_-Baird Billiard Parlor, and R. M. Vaughn.
- .0029 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – Charles H. Minogue Auto Supplies at 55 West Main Street. Photo is glued to an album page with a piece of the company's letterhead or business card glued below the photo.

- .0074 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – showroom interior, Kranz Brothers General Marble and Tile Contractors ("All contracts subject to strikes, fires, accidents, and other causes beyond our control"), offices and showrooms at 20 North Limestone Street. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0075 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, Lobenherz "Purity" Bakery (United States Food Administration License Number B-00228) at either 14 East High Street or 33 North Lowry Avenue (probably the High Street address). Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0076 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, Joe C. O'Brien, Undertaker at 24 South Spring Street, showing hearse parked in garage. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0077 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, Michael Tire Company at the corner of Fountain Avenue and North Street. A man in a suit, presumably Michael himself, is standing on the sidewalk outside the shop. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0078 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, Ray's Cigars & Billiards at 108 West Main Street. Photo is glued to an album page and there is a piece of paper with information about the company glued below it.
- .0079 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – interior, the Pantitorium at 17 West High Street; shows a brick-walled room containing a rack of clothing on one side and heavy-duty clothes presses on the other. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0080 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, George S. Lambert Dry Cleaning and Pressing at 206 North Fountain Avenue. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo; letterhead has been amended with a typewriter to change the company's address and phone number.

- .0082 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, the Edward Wren Men's Store (branch) on South Limestone Street. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.

- .0086 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – interior, Fairbanks Billiard Parlor, second floor of the Fairbanks Building. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0087 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, the Indiana, Columbus, & Eastern Traction Company (Ohio Electric Depot) in the Interurban Building. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0088 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, the Springfield Pure Milk Company/The Springfield Dairy Products Company (sign on building reads the former, letterhead below photo the latter). - .0089 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – interior, Exide Battery Station at Main and Lowry Avenue. Shows an area of a larger room with a generator (?) in one corner, shelves full of what appear to be automotive batteries, with a table in the center full of batteries hooked up to what must be some sort of charging station. Some of the batteries on the shelves have names painted on them. On the other side of the shelves two cars or trucks are parked

- inside the building. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
- .0090 Photo, B&W, 8" x 10" – exterior, American Restaurant at the corner of Limestone and Washington Streets. Photo is glued to an album page with the company's letterhead glued below the photo.
