Dick got out of the army after WWII and served in ETO in Europe - came back and went to Witt, played football and then he did post grad at Kent State in education - Dick wanted to bring Neil Armstrong for a commencement at (Clark County Technical Institute at the start - before they got state recognition to be called a College) -
