

Firemen's Pensions Small Collection Category – Roberds Fire Department Collection

BACKGROUND

Calvin E. Roberds was born in Springfield in 1923. He was educated in the Springfield Public School system and attended Wittenberg for a year before serving in the armed forces from 1943 to 1945. When he returned to Springfield he was employed by the William Bayley Company, and later the International Harvester Company.

Roberds had volunteered as a civil defense firefighter at the start of WWII, and served on the plant fire brigade during his days at International. These activities were an outgrowth of a life-long interest in firefighting. This interest finally became a career in 1953 when Roberds joined the Springfield Fire Department. He was promoted to Lieutenant in 1961 and Captain in 1970. Concerned by the lack of written information about the history of the Springfield Fire Department, he began to research the subject, and published his findings in *150 Years: From Buckets to Diesels*. Roberds retired in 1985. He was active in the CF Water Group, was at one time the president of the Clark County Historical Society, and enjoyed playing the organ and keyboard. He died in 1995.
